2023 - 2024

The applicant must

- 1. be graduating this year or have graduated in the previous school year
 - from a secondary school in District 68 (Nanaimo/Ladysmith), 69 (Parksville/Qualicum Beach), 70 (Pacific Rim), or 71 (Courtenay/ Comox)

or

- be a member or a spouse, child, or grandchild of a member in good standing with the Guild
- be pursuing a degree or a diploma in textile arts or fashion design.
 A degree or diploma in Fine Arts and Graphic Design will be considered if the candidate demonstrates that these will be related to fibre/textile arts or fashion design.
- 3. demonstrate, by means of a portfolio, their interest in fibre/ textile Arts or fashion design
- 4. currently be at, or have identified, a program at an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution
- 5. The applicant preferably will have completed a course of study in textiles or fashion design.

In addition to meeting the criteria, the candidate must provide a

- 1. transcript of grades for grade 11 and 12 courses
- 2. letter of recommendation from a teacher
- 3. letter from the applicant indicating
 - why he/she deserves the scholarship
 - plans for education and subsequent career
 - plans for affiliation with the Guild, if any
